I. Introduction to LEED

The seven parts to LEED are as follows

- Sustainable Sites** (SS) i.e. sustainable grounds and landscape mgmt.
- Water Efficiency** (WE) i.e. monitoring & reducing water consumption.
- Energy and Atmosphere** (EA) i.e. monitoring & improving energy performance.
- Materials and Resources** (MR) i.e. purchase products with recycled content.
- Indoor Environmental Quality** (IEQ) i.e. green cleaning, green chem/equip.
- Innovation in Operations** (IO)
- Regional Priority** (RP)

II. Steps to follow in Certification Process

III. Indoor Environmental Quality (IEQ)

The IEQ part of LEED is the area that applies most specifically to cleaning. One of the requirements is to implement green cleaning. Important to emphasize that green cleaning is a specific process that included the use of products.
