

Carpet Spotting Guide

General Spotting Techniques

- 1. Use only enough spotter to wet, do not soak stained area.
- 2. Use brush to work chemical into stain and agitate the stained carpet. Do not use carpet brush to brush across carpet - damage to fibers may occur.
- 3. After a stain has been loosened with 101 Carpet Spotter, 103 Take-Out or **102 Beverage Stain Remover**, it should be rinsed from the carpet by extraction. Clear water should be used in the extractor. If an extractor is not available, clear water can be sprayed on the carpet and vacuumed out with a wet/dry vacuum. If a wet/dry vacuum is not available, a white terry-cloth towel can be used to blot the liquid out.

102 Beverage Stain Remover

Formlated to remove coffee, tea, cola, beer, fruit juice, mustard, jam, jelly, urine, and other similar stains. Formlated with mild citric acid.

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103 Take-Out

General purpose spotter for removing High performance carpet spotter formulated greases, oils, traffic spots and other to remove food stains. Also used for blood, Pint 902191

104 Bio-Power

Biological odor neutralizer. Use to neutralize putrid odors from stale urine, rotting garbage and other similar sources.

105 Non-Volatile Dry Spotter

Solvent blend formulated to remove paint, oil, grease and ink stains. Contains ino chlorinated solvents. Pint 902111

Squirt a small amount of 105 Non-Volatile Dry Spotter on the stain. Work it into the stain with the carpet brush. Blot with a white, absorbent cloth.	1. Squirt a small amount of 101 Carpet Spotter onto the stain. Work it in with the carpet brush and extract with clear water.	1. Squirt 103 Take-Out onto the stain. Work it in with the carpet brush. Allow it to act on the stain for a minimum of 30 minutes before proceeding.	1. Squirt a small amount of 102 Beverage Stain Remover onto the stain. Work it in with the carpet brush and extract with clear water.	1. If exact location of the urine stain is unknown, use a UV (black) light - with normal lights turned off - to locate stain.
2. Repeat,if necessary. 3. If any stain remains, squirt a small amount of 101 Carpet Spotter on the stain. Work it in with the carpet brush and extract with clear water.	 Squirt a small amount of 102 Beverage Stain Remover onto the remaining stain. Work it in with the carpet brush and extract with clear water. If there is any stain remaining, squirt a small amount of 101 Carpet Spotter on it, work it in with the carpet brush and extract with clear water. Then squirt a small amount of 103 Take-Out onto the stain. Work it in with the carpet brush. Allow it to work for a minimum of 30 minutes and extract with clear water. 	 Squirt a small amount of 101 Carpet Spotter onto the remaining stain. Work it in with the carpet brush and extract with clear water. If there is any stain remaining, apply 102 Beverage Stain Remover to it. Work it in with the carpet brush and extract with clear water. 	 Squirt a small amount of 101 Carpet Spotter onto the remaining stain. Work it in with the carpet brush and extract with clear water. If there is any stain remaining, squirt a small amount of 103 Take-Out on it. Work it in with the carpet brush. Allow it to act on the stain for a minimum of 30 minutes. Extract with clear water. 	 Squirt a small amount of 101 Carpet Spotter on the stained area. Work it in with the carpet brush and extract with clear water. Squirt a small amount of 102 Beverage Stain Remover onto the stained area. Work it in with the carpet brush and extract with clear water. Repeat Step 2 (not Step 3). Apply 104 Bio-Power to the stained area. Apply a sufficient amount to moisten the carpet backing. Do not, however, over-wet the carpet. Work it in with the carpet brush.
