What make Hydrogen Peroxide Special

Chlorine Bleach (Household Bleach) is also an oxidizing agent but with some very important differences when compared to Hydrogen Peroxide.

pH of common solutions	Acidic pH of 3-4	Alkaline, pH of 12

Hydrogen peroxide for cleaning is formulated in solutions characterized as a mildly acidic pH, which makes the hydrogen peroxide shelf stable. The mildly acidic pH also aids in cleaning pH sensitive soils like hard water, soap scum, grout, etc.
